


Find piece #4, DOLPHIN FIN. Stitch top fin 1. pieces, right sides together, on a 1/4 " seam allowance. notch your curves and turn fin right side out. Press, and stuff lightly with fiberfil.




2. Find piece #1, DOLPHIN BODY. Match the raw edge of the fin to the top of one layer of the dolphin body, (right side of the fabric) between the dots. Stitch to the dolphin body at a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.)








3. Put both layers of the DOLPHIN BODY (piece #1) right sides together. Using a 1/4' seam allowance, stitch the top seam.








6. Find piece #2. Stitch center seam. Right Sides together on a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Leave an opening between the dots. As shown.



7. Pin dolphin stomach to dolphin body, right sides together. Match dots fist, using pins. While stitching, stretch stomach slightly to fit. Notch your curves.



Notch your curves. Turn Fn Right Side out and lightly stuff fins.

Pin side fins to dolphin body at placements. Stitch across seam allowances to hold in place.

Find piece #5. DOLPHIN SIDE FIN. Stitch the

side fin together separately on a 1/4" seam
